The Norwegian Defence Research Establishment (FFI) carries out experiments in laboratories and the field in order to examine the potential in communications technology and how new technology can be used. The objective is to get FFI one or several broadband radio products in order to fulfil laboratory and field testing needs. In this tender FFI requests tenders for a radio system consisting of individual nodes capable of creating an ad hoc network, independent of the base or master station that uses frequencies in the military frequency band (VHF 30 — 88 MHz and/or UHF 225 — 400 MHz), alternatively also on an unlicensed band. In addition we would also like tenders for tactical satellite communication with wavelength (UHF

225-400 MHz), either on the same hardware as MANET or as a separate system. Further information is in the tender documentation chapter 4.
