- assisting producers – including those following approved production processes – through key stages of product development, from early assessment to ongoing due diligence testing. This includes, where necessary and feasible, providing guidance on Sustainability Certification Schemes;
- contributing to efforts to streamline the existing fuel approval process without compromising product performance and safety.
