The system will also enable the recommended work to be packaged and programmed and allocated to internal works teams as well as external contractors.

The system will also help the CWGC to grow its information database and improve the future management of our estate, including but not limited to statutory compliance.

CWGC manages and maintains an estate of over 23 000 sites across 154 countries. The estate comprises mostly historic property assets (over 3 000 sites) and headstones (over 1 000 000), but also some non-historic property assets such as offices and base sites.
