It is anticipated that 5 firms will be invited to tender subject to that number qualifying. Tender Stage Those invited to tender, will be issued with a minimum based specification, award criteria and pricing documents and invited to submit tenders. The Contracting Authority will evaluate those tenders against the award criteria and reserves the right to: Move straight to a contract award decision, without negotiation To invite all firms to negotiation meetings. To apply the successive reduction rule to reduce the number of firms invited to the negotiation phase. The selection of firms may be based on scenarios where firms have failed to qualify under one or more of the award criteria and/or situations where there is a clear score differential following evaluation of the initial tenders, which may on occasion mean only inviting one firm where they are a clear winner. The Negotiation Stage Invitation to attend a negotiation meeting at which all aspects of the tender submitted may be discussed, including costs. Those tenderers will be accorded an

opportunity to submit a Best and Final Offer (BAFO), which will be assessed against the award criteria. It should be emphasised that the Contracting Authority reserves the right to award the contract directly following receipt of initial tenders without recourse to negotiations with individual tenderers.
