1) A brief description of the primary deliveries in the last three years, including information on the contract value, date of delivery, number of delivery points, and the name of the contracting authority and a description of the assignment content.

Alternative: Certificate for the company's quality system/management system issued by independent bodies which certify that the tenderer fulfils certain quality assurance standards, for example ISO 9001:2015.

3) A description of the tenderer's environmental management measures. If the tenderer has certificates from independent bodies that can substantiate an established environmental management system, certificates thereof shall be presented as documentation.

The contracting authority refers in this connection to the EMAS (Eco-Management and Audit Scheme), or other acknowledged environmental management systems stated in the decree (EF) no. 1221/2009 article 45, such as the Environmental Lighthouse Scheme, or other environmental management standards that are based on relevant European or international standards from accredited bodies, e.g., ISO 14001.

4) Copy of ethical guidelines.

A brief description of what has been done/is planned to be done to implement ethical guidelines for the selection of new sub-suppliers and for quality assurance of existing sub-suppliers.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

Requirement:

1) Tenderers must have experience from equivalent contracts.

Equivalent contracts means contracts with minimum 100 delivery points.

2) Tenderers must have a quality assurance system adapted to the content of the contract.

3) A quality assurance system must be established that ensures that the tenderer is suitable to fulfil the contractual obligations for environmental regulations (see contract point 6.5). This means that the tenderer must have established methods for working actively and systematically with reducing negative environmental impact from the tenderer activities related to the implementation of this contract.

4) Tenderers must have ethical guidelines (guidelines for social responsibility/Code of Conduct /Suppliers Code of Conduct or equivalent), which as a minimum are equivalent to the social contract terms for the delivery in this procurement (Joint Contract point 6.6). The guidelines must, amongst other things, cover procurements and supplier chain management. The guidelines must be signed by the Managing Director or equivalent.

Tenderers must work actively to ensure compliance with the tenderer's ethical guidelines at sub-suppliers, including through selection criteria for new sub-suppliers and quality assurance methods for existing sub-suppliers.

A quality assurance system is required which ensures that the tenderer is suitable to fulfil the contractual obligations for social requirements (see contract section 6.6). This means that the tenderer has methods for managing the supplier chain and tracking systems that enable follow-up of compliance with:

- Basic human rights, including, amongst other things:
 - no person must be subjected to torture or gruesome, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment (UN's Universal Declaration of Human Rights art. 5),
 - all workers have the right to fair and good payment that ensures them and their family a dignified existence, and if necessary, complemented by other social protection (UN's Universal Declaration of Human Rights art. 23.3),
 - everyone has the right to rest and leisure time, including reasonable limiting of work hours and regular holidays with pay. (UN's Universal Declaration of Human Rights art. 24).
- ILO's core conventions:
 - ILO convention no. 138 and 182 (ban on child labour), nos. 29 and 105 (ban on discrimination) and numbers 100 and 111 (ban on discrimination) and nos. 87 and 98 (freedom of association and right to collective bargaining).
- International law's regulations that related to the delivery in this agreement, including relevant UN decisions that Norway have signed.
