This contract is a non-exclusive Framework Agreement with Economic Operator(s) to provide Advance Processing of Wireline Log Data to support shale gas reservoir evaluation and associated services required for Company's shale gas programme in Romania and Bulgaria. Economic Operators must be in a position to provide the services as and when required by Company. Call-offs against the Framework will be issued to the provider with the most economically advantageous Framework Agreement and Company will use the same criteria as stated in the Framework Agreement invitation to tender. Only where the terms laid down in the Framework Agreement are not enough for a particular call off will Company hold a mini-competition with all the providers awarded a Framework Agreement and capable of meeting the particular needs against the terms and conditions of the agreed Framework Agreement. The Advance Processing of Wireline Log Data Framework Agreement may include either or all the requirements below, as one single Framework Agreement or separate Framework Agreements that might be awarded to different Economic Operators. Preference will be given to Economic Operators who can provide the most from the list of services below.

- 1) Interpretation of Image Logs and integrating results with core descriptions:
 - a) image processing and quick auto dip picking;
 - b) full manual dip picking and structural interpretation;
 - c) structural analysis;
 - d) sedimentary interpretation;
 - e) facies analysis;
 - f) fracture analyses;
 - g) integration with core;
 - h) integration with stoneley.

2) Interpretation of Stoneley Wave acoustics from sonic log processing of sonic log data and analysis of the compressional, shear and Stoneley wave velocities and characterisation of the anisotropy. Vertical Transverse Isotropy (VTI) resulting from the intrinsic nature of the rock matrix will be characterised, as well as stress induced anisotropy and that caused by natural fractures. Results to be integrated with other wireline datasets (eg VSP and FMI) as appropriate.

3) Processing of VSP data processing of borehole seismic data, acquired during Vertical Seismic Profile (VSP) and Walkway VSP operations. Processing to be designed to enhance primary objectives of the surveys, in conjunction with other datasets (such as wireline logs):

- a) establishing time versus depth relationship over the full depth of the survey;
- b) produce corridor stack, to tie with the surface seismic and provide estimate of Q;
- c) Vertical Transverse Isotropy (VTI) parameter estimation of the overburden and reservoir sections;
- d) characterisation of Amplitude versus Angle (AVA) response at the reservoir section;
- e) high resolution 2D imaging of target section.

Company will only consider operators with the technical ability and demonstrated experience necessary to provide Advance Processing of Wireline Log Data services in Romania and Bulgaria.
