The provision of alternative treatment settings will also support the reduction in demand for secondary care. The community Ophthalmology service will be provided under the 'Any Qualified Provider' model. All providers will be required to provide the core adult service and may also choose to offer additional optional services.

Specific conditions to be assessed and/or treated are Glaucoma, Cataracts and age related Macular Degeneration.
