Suppliers invited to tender will be required to supply samples of some of the items required for the supply of eyewear, that, in their judgement, best meets the specifications as appropriate. All samples offered will be subject to an assessment process. The precise criteria will be detailed in the tender documents. Samples required for the tender evaluation shall be supplied by potential Suppliers free of charge. The announcement of this future requirement is not to be construed as confirmation that a tender/contract will subsequently be issued; announcements are for information only. The issue of a possible future purchase notice, or the issue of an invitation to tender, is not to be construed as a commitment by the MOD to place an order as a result of the tendering exercise or at a later stage. Any expenditure, work or effort undertaken prior to contract award is a matter solely for the commercial judgement of potential Suppliers.
