NHS Bromley Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) (the Contracting Authority) is seeking to identify a suitable provider of Primary Care GP Services to undertake a GP caretaking contract in London for Trinity Medical Centre based at 33 Croydon Road, Penge, London SE20 7TJ. The successful Bidder will be required to provide general medical services at the address of the Practice referred to above, using the current clinical staff and non-clinical staff, where employed, to ensure some continuity of service provision for patients. The successful Bidder will also be required to ensure that the Practice is managed and run to meet the needs of the registered patients, ensuring that high quality general medical services are provided in a consistent and accessible way. This will include providing clinical leadership to the practice team at the Practice and ensuring robust governance processes are in place. The successful Bidder will also be required to sign a lease or license of the premises with the current owner of the premises.

This Tender process is being managed by NEL CSU (NEL) on behalf of Bromley Clinical Commissioning Group (the “Contracting Authority”) in connection with a competitive procurement exercise that is being conducted in accordance with a process based on the open procedure under the Public Contract Regulations 2015 (“the Regulations” (as amended)). The services to which this Procurement relates fall within the “Light Touch Regime” (LTR) governing procurement of health, social, education and other service contracts.
