Documentation requirement: A credit rating based on the most recent fiscal figures. The rating must be carried out by a credit rating agency with a licence to provide such service.

Requirement: Tenderers must have experience from comparable assignments.

Documentation requirement: Description of up to three of the most relevant assignments during the last three years. The description must include a statement of the assignment value, dates and recipients (name, telephone number and e-mail address). It is the tenderer's responsibility to confirm relevance through the description. Tenderers can document experience by referring to the competence of personnel at disposal for this assignment, including experience that has been acquired while personnel performed services for another supplier.

The contracting authority reserves the right to contact the references.

Tenderers must have a well-functioning quality assurance system and check routines for the services that will be provided.

Documentation requirement: Tenderers must document and give an account of their quality assurance system and check routines for the services that will be provided. An example of such documentation is a ISO 9001 certificate.
