Bioforsk, hereafter called the Contracting Authority, is organised under the Ministry of Agriculture and Food (LMD) as an administrative body with special authority.

Bioforsk operates two canteens at Ås in Akershus. Bioforsk would like to enter into a framework agreement for all procurements of fruit and vegetables for the operation of the canteens. The canteens have slightly different requirements, but it has been decided to run this as a single procurement. Tenderer must be a full-range supplier for this type of delivery, and shall have a broad product range to offer the Contracting Authority.
