The Norwegian Public Roads Administration shall, during summer 2018, decide on a concept for crossing Bjørnafjorden. Work shall be thus carried out to further develop and optimise the concept for a multi-span suspension bridge on floating foundations for crossing Bjørnafjorden. This shall form the basis of maturing the project to the FEED stage.

each of the assignments. If a tenderer would like to offer the same key personnel and/or project manager for several of the assignments, the tenderer shall set up a prioritised order for the tenders, so that the highest priority is valid if a tenderer is considered as the winner of several of the competitions.

This means that a tenderer's tender for lower ranked competition(s) cannot be deemed to be binding and it will be covered by the Public Procurement Regulations § 20-13 (2) d.
