The Contracting Authority requests tenders for consultancy services concerning planning and engineering assignments. The tender shall be a basis for a framework agreement with several service providers.

The contractual works involve a framework agreement for planning and engineering design of several smaller and medium sized assignments in Region Mid-Norway.

Due to unpredictable workloads, it is very difficult to give exact figures on the expected purchase of planning and engineering design services. An indicative valuation on the framework agreement per year is approx. 30 000 000 NOK - 60 000 000 NOK.
