The tender contest applies to the delivery of various masses (gravel and crushed stone). The contract value is estimated to be above the EEA threshold value. The need is uncertain. Historically, the contracting authority has procured products for NOK 900,000 excluding VAT per year in recent years. The value can be both higher and lower, and will depend on, among other things, the contracting authority's needs, activities, budgetary situation and other framework factors.

The contracting authority will enter into a contract with 1 supplier for each zone.

The contracting authority expects that the tenderer studies the contractual terms and makes the required internal clarifications in such a way that a contract can be signed if awarded.

The certificate must not be more than 6 months from the deadline for tenders. The contracting authority is not allowed to request the certificate if already submitted, in accordance with the regulations, § 17-1(4). If you have submitted a tax certificate to the contracting authority and it is still valid at the time of the tender submission for this contest, you are not obliged to submit a certificate now. If this is the case, state when and to whom the certificate was previously submitted. You can, however, attach the certificate voluntarily if you want.
