Eurofound has launched an open procedure for supply of electricity in 2017 which failed due to no tenders received despite approaching all utility suppliers licensed for the Irish energy market. Subsequently, Eurofound entered into direct negotiations with one of the suppliers who expressed an interest in the tender and concluded a contract for 2-year period using negotiated procedure without prior publication of a call for competition. Following expiry of this contract, Eurofound entered into direct negotiations with the incumbent electricity supplier using Article 32 of Directive 2014/24/EU in order to secure the electricity supply for another 2-year period.
