##### **II.1.4. Short description**

Patient discharge service (PDS) is a subset of Patient transport service (PTS) and renamed Discharge patient transport services (DPTS). It caters for patients who without effective, safe transport could have further problems due to difficulties returning home or to a place of care. Journeys will be required both with advance notice and 'on the day'.

This can and should encompass a wide range of vehicle types and levels of care consistent with the patients' medical needs.

To provide three (3) separate, dedicated discharge services that operate out of three different acute hospitals:

- Barnsley Hospital NHS Foundation Trust,
- The Rotherham Hospital NHS Trust,
- Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.

The aim of the service is to ensure that the overarching principle of DPTS is followed and achieved; patients who are eligible for transport will receive safe, timely and comfortable transport to their destination, without detriment to their medical condition.
