The Institute for Energy and Transport (IET) is one of the 7 scientific institutes of the Joint Research Centre (JRC), a Directorate-General of the European Commission (EC). A control room (approximately 80 m²) is required on the site of the IET in Petten (Netherlands). This control room will be an annexe to the existing bunker on the site (Building 319), in which high-pressure experiments are conducted. These experiments shall be controlled and monitored from the control room.

The control room shall have individual rooms, such as for monitoring, a workshop, toilets and a shower.

The works include the construction of the control room, including installations, e.g. concrete foundations, steel trusses, sandwich panels, steel roofing sheets, and data, compressed-air, electrical, ventilation, heating and cooling systems.

Following final acceptance, the contractor must provide a 12-month maintenance guarantee.
