II.2.1. Total quantity or scope

A device and technology agnostic service working across Android smartphones, iPhones, Blackberry smartphones, standard mobile phones, Windows PDA and dedicated lone worker devices such as an ID badge or 2 way communication key fob. The service will provide a means for lone workers to log in and out of daily tasks, leaving details of their location and the expected duration. If an activity over runs the service will automatically call the lone worker to verify their safety. If the lone worker cannot be reached a nominated respondent will be notified informing them of the over run activity. Should the lone worker feel that their safety has been compromised at any time then they can press a dedicated hot key on a chosen lone worker device to summon emergency assistance. The service would provide the lone workers personal details, activity details and live audio to the respondent receiving the escalated call with the ability for the respondent to connect to a live feed through the users handset for further emergency audio. The contract will cover licensing, rental/lease of any dedicated lone worker devices and any SIMS required for same (Oaklee Homes Group will provide its own phones), helpdesk support, technical support and training. Billing terms must be open and flexible to allow Oaklee Homes Group to add and remove users from the service within the contract term, without affecting the term, as staffing levels change.
