Re:allies wishes to procure and enter into a framework agreement with multiple suppliers, each of which will be required to supply and distribute a broad range of goods required primarily for responsive maintenance of housing stock and also the planned maintenance and construction of housing stock. The goods will be supplied to the customer via a range of different supply models including access to a counter, a delivery service, van stock replenishment or managed store. The choice of the supply method will vary according to the needs of the individual customer. Appointed suppliers must be able to manage transactions arising from the supply of the goods.
