For the proposed research, accurate control of light intensity (0 to 1,000 mol(PAR)), far red /red ratio, day length, temperature (-10 to 45°C), relative humidity (40 to 85 %), carbon dioxide level (0 to 2,000 ppm) and airflow is needed.
