Assignments under the framework agreement can also include engineering design services for camera surveillance in projects (new buildings, extensions, renovations, etc.).

The delivery of an alarm centre with security guard services for handling events and surveillance, combined with alarm sensors, access control, etc., can be included in the framework agreement. This will be clarified if the need arises in the contract period.

The contracting authority currently has centralised camera surveillance for 27 schools and multi-purpose halls with approx. 270 cameras in operation. Several schools are in queue for camera surveillance.

Assignments under the framework agreement can also include engineering design services for camera surveillance in projects (new buildings, extensions, renovations, etc.).

The delivery of an alarm centre with security guard services for handling events and surveillance, combined with alarm sensors, access control, etc., can be included in the framework agreement. This will be clarified if the need arises in the contract period. Deliveries will be based on orders from Oslo Municipality when there is a need for surveillance at the schools in Oslo.

The framework agreement period will be 2 years from when the contract is signed. The contracting authority has an option to extend the framework agreement for 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 year. The total maximum framework agreement period is, thus 6 years.

A framework agreement will be signed with one tenderer. As the framework agreement involves both installation work at the schools and handling the surveillance data, etc., the chosen tenderer must have broad competence to fulfil the deliveries.
