The tenderers must have settled financial conditions and the financial capacity to fulfil the contract.

The contracting authority will obtain the credit rating Commercial Delphi Score from Experian. Tenderers must as a minimum achieve a rating of "credit worthy", i.e. the tenderer must be in risk classification 5 or higher on the Experian scale.

The tenderer is expected to have familiarised himself with registered information about the company and by submission of the tender accepts that the information will be obtained and form the basis of the assessment of the tenderer's financial situation.

Companies registered in other countries than Norway must enclose a credit rating. The credit rating must be provided by a recognised credit rating company that demonstrates that the tenderer fulfils the requirement. The credit rating must be based on the most recent available accounts and it must be carried out by an agency licensed to carry out credit rating activity.

If a tenderer has valid reasons for not being able to provide the documentation requested by the contracting authority, the tenderer can document their economic and financial capacity by presenting other documents considered suitable by the contracting authority.
