The initial focus for the laboratory is the establishment of a high quality monitor system with an integrated surround system and the operation thereof Other elements will be installed continuously after the monitor is in place, but the Contracting Authority also requests camera systems as an option in tender contest.

The delivery of a camera/video system. A clear and defined goal is the establishment and development of a laboratory that is unique among the existing laboratories and the laboratory shall offer world leading solutions. The contracting authority expects that it is impossible to reach this goal without a close co-operation between the suppliers and the users of the laboratory.

The objective of the support and maintenance agreement is to ensure stable and reliable operations of the system during the expected practical operating time.
