2.1. Procedure

Title: ÅM-25-08 Tank lorry

Description: Åmot municipality intends to procure a tank lorry for the fire and rescue service.

This shall be an operative and functional vehicle that covers the need for turn-outs, fire-extinguishing and rescue assignments in the municipality. The procurement shall contribute to maintaining and strengthening the stand-by, as well as ensuring safe and effective efforts in incidents. Tenderers shall use their expertise and competence to contribute to fulfilling the aim of the contract.

Main features of the procedure: The procurement is for the delivery of a tank lorry for the fire service that shall cover the municipality's need for emergency response, fire extinguishing and rescue assignments. Newer used vehicles can be offered. The vehicle shall be in good technical condition and ready for operative use when delivered. It is a requirement that both the chassis and addition shall be from 2022 or newer. The tanker shall not have a driving distance above 50,000 kilometres. It shall be equipped with a water tank and pump with sufficient capacity to handle the most common fire scenarios in the municipality, and the vehicle is expected to have a single cabin with room for two persons. The fire engine must be certified in accordance with THE EU rules and it shall be presented with full documentation of the service and maintenance history. It is a prerequisite that the vehicle is equipped with basic fire and rescue equipment and that the tenderer is responsible for transport and delivery to the fire station in the municipality. A brief training shall also be given for the use and maintenance of the vehicle for relevant personnel for the hand-over. See the attached requirement specifications for a complete overview of the type of vehicle and equipment that shall be procured.
