The Royal Marsden NHS Foundation Trust is a Specialist Oncology Centre seeking to appoint a supplier who will be able to deliver Haematology Full Blood Count (FBC) service.

The Trust's haematology service is provided to inpatients, outpatients and day cases, providing rapid turn-around times (within 20 minutes) for the latter 2 groups. We do not provide GP services. The Trust is also heavily involved in trial work in liaison with the Institute for Cancer Research.

There is currently a full haematology service at both sites site operating 24 hour 7 day cover.

The blood sciences department currently holds full UKAS accreditation under ISO 15189 and is enrolled in all relevant UK EQA schemes for tests conducted within its routine laboratories.
