VI.4.2. Review procedure

Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures: Complaints must be received in the Board of Appeal within 45 days from the day following the publication in the Official Journal of the European Union that the contracting authority has signed a contract or within 6 months from the contracting authority informed the tenderers whom the contracting authority will conclude contracts with, if it is a framework agreement. According to the Law on Enforcement of Procurement Rules, Act No 492 of 12.5.2010, with subsequent amendments, the Danish Nature Agency 1st sign the contract with the successful bidder (s) 10 days after the notification is sent to all bidders by e-mail. If complaint is received by the Board of Appeal before the expiry of the standstill period, the complaint automatically has temporary suspensive effect, until the Board of Appeal has ruled on whether an appeal has suspensive effect.
