Sandefjord Municipality currently has approx. 750 pupils of the relevant age, split between 6 secondary schools (from 50 - 150 pupils per school).

All pupils in the 8th year, approx. 750 pupils (split between 6 schools) for the school year 2026 /2027, must be offered a school camp stay of four days / three nights.
