The main objective of this RFP is to award a contract to one provider for the services for a trading surveillance solution and for the services thereunder, for a term of four (4) years. The scope of this RFP is to procure a solution that will assist NBIM with minimizing and preventing breaches of regulatory obligations, focusing on the identification and follow up of potential market abuse and market manipulation (e.g. insider dealing). In acquiring such a solution, the aim is to automate workflows that process a large amount of trade data and create meaningful alerts. The solution should have a complete alert library covering existing regulations for cross-asset instruments addressing e.g. actual as well as attempted market manipulation and market abuse

The contract shall also cover implementation and maintenance of the proposed solution.

The estimated value of this procurement over a four (4) period is in the range 6 000 000 — 12 000 000 NOK, but this should only be considered an estimate and should not in any way be considered binding upon NBIM, and thus the actual contract value may be higher or lower.
