The Support for Independent Living in Staffordshire (SILIS) Service will enable vulnerable older and disabled people to maintain their independence, health and well-being in their home and community.

There will be a review of Disabled Facilities Grants (DFGs) by the Government (expected Winter 2017-18) and the content of the Service Specification will be dependent on what is permitted under the new guidance. In the Services Specification 'Required' services are those services specified under the current legislation and 'Additional' services are those services the guidance may be amended to include. Therefore the Contracting Body intends to buy the 'Required' services and may buy the 'Additional' services.

The supplier of the SILIS Service may opt to directly provide these services, or may wish to sub-contract or work with other agencies in a consortia arrangement to deliver the services. A key aim of the Service is to help Individuals to make changes to their home environment that will prevent the need for more costly interventions, such as admission to hospital or residential care, following life crises.

The Service will deliver:

- i. a high quality information and advice service which is multi-channel;
- ii. a seamless, joined-up approach to service delivery between partner agencies;
- iii. ability to control implementation of an Individuals' chosen option where possible;
- iv. support to exercise choice for Individuals where required;
- v. timely delivery once the chosen option is decided by the Individual;
- vi. a single point of contact and good feedback about progress.

The Service will improve upon the following existing services:

- vii. Home Improvement Agency (HIA);
- viii. Assistive Technology (AT) including referral to telecare providers;
- ix. independent living centres;
- x. the administration of financial support for disabled adaptations and repairs and moving to a more suitable home where this is permitted under the legislation.

Lodging of Appeals — Precise information on deadline(s) for lodging appeals: The Contracting Authority will incorporate a minimum 10 calendar day standstill period (or 15 days where non-electronic or fax methods are used) at the point that an award decision notice is communicated to tenderers.

The award decision process will specify the criteria for the award of the contract/framework agreement, the reasons for the decision, including the characteristics and relative advantages, the name and score of the successful tender; and will specify when the standstill period is expected to end or the date before which the Contracting Authority will not conclude the contract/framework agreement.

If an appeal regarding the award of a contract/framework agreement has not been successfully resolved, the Public Contracts Regulations 2015 provide for aggrieved parties who have been harmed or are at risk of a breach of the rules to take action in the High Court (England, Wales and Northern Ireland).

Any such action must be brought promptly (generally within 3 months). The Court may order the setting aside of the award decision or may order the Contracting Authority to amend any document and may award damages.

If an agreement has been entered into the Court may make a declaration of ineffectiveness or may order that the duration of any relevant specific contract be shortened and additionally may award damages.

The time limit for seeking such a declaration is generally 30 days from notification of the award (either by award decision notification or contract award notice depending upon the circumstances) or otherwise 6 months.
