The contract currently offers a financial return to St Francis of Assisi Catholic Technology College each year, with the only charges being made in respect of hospitality and free issues. This equates to an annual charge of 28 000.00 GBP approximately. The level of cash sales has increased over the term of the current contract.

The duration of the contract being offered is three years commencing on 1.4.2017 and concluding on 31.3.2020 and will be on a guaranteed performance basis.

It is hoped that the successful contractor will make inward capital investment to improve the catering services offered to both staff and pupils within the School. In particular this should be focused on improving the catering facilities. Consideration should also be given to the implementation of a cashless catering system moving into this contract term.
