A maximum of five companies shall be invited to tender. If more than 5 companies express an interest, then companies shall be selected on the basis of their response to the following evaluation criteria. Evidence must be submitted by the 9.10.2012:

- A) Evidence of the organisations mission, size and structure. This evidence should include a copy of the organisations most recent financial accounts;
- B) Evidence of the methods of ensuring the quality of the service, in meeting the needs of the customer and keeping it fully up to date with current practice;
- C) Details of any site protection services carried out with either MOD or Other Government Departments (OGD) within the last 3 years;
- D) Details of work covering site protection services carried out with Private Sector companies within the last three years.

Companies are advised that if they have recently submitted similar evidence for other requirements, they should make reference to this in their response to this advertisement, including the appropriate reference number and contact details of the individual to whom the information was sent.
