The framework has an initial duration of 24 months with options for 2 12-month extensions. The maximum length of the framework will therefore be 4 years.

Whilst there is no guaranteed quantity or spend, the estimated value ordered through CORMAC Solutions Ltd, CORSERV Ltd, Cornwall Council and the family of wholly owned companies is likely to be in the region of 250 000 GBP to 3 000 000 GBP per annum. The potential estimated total value is likely to exceed this range if other organisations decide to participate.

The services will be for the whole of CORMAC Solutions Ltd, all directorates of Cornwall Council, plus Parish, Town and City Councils, and other public sector bodies (including Schools, Housing Associations / Housing Management Organisations, Police, NHS / Primary Care Trusts etc.), who may at a later date adopt the terms and conditions of the framework agreement.
