The electronic presentation of a case shall require the transformation of various forms of source material into a dynamic representation of that data in a digital format that is easily understandable and can be presented in a court setting; e.g. to a judge and jury. If required, all source material shall be incorporated in a single user interface.

Possible requirements may include, but will not be limited to, examples such as the following:

- creation of a chronological timeline with the facility to link to related documents and other source materials;
- forensic injury mapping — including interpretation of pathologist report;
- facial mapping — including interpretation of pathologist report;
- closed circuit television and video enhancement;
- audio enhancement;
- scene reconstruction (including animations);
- geographic maps illustrating activities at various sites;
- collation of documents in a coherent browser enabling efficient search and document linking;
- mobile telephony site/route analysis mapping;
- virtual tour technology;
- moving image enhancement – e.g. by circling an individual in a recording;
- moving image annotation;
- pixelation and voice distortion, to maintain and ensure witness anonymity.

All supplier personnel working on this contract must hold SC level clearance.
