- new electric 24 v system in the engine room and aft room, moving of septic tank,
- new diesel pipes, new hydraulic pipes with deck guides, new lighting 220 v in machinery, removal of compressor and air ash, washing/painting of engine room, new engine room fan, fire alarm/extinguishing system, camera monitoring of the engine room, and proposal for tank gauge systems for diesel and water.
