Nkom needs external consultancy services for planning and implementing the assignment in 2 x 30 MHz for mobile services in the 700 MHz band.

The assignment period will consist of 2 phases:

1. The 1st phase will consist of setting the total framework for the award, which includes, for example, assignment format, possibly frequency 'lid' and reserve prices.
2. In the 2nd phase, the consultant shall assist Nkom in determining the detailed rules for the award, developing the auction software and assist Nkom during the implementation of the auction.
