The purpose of the procurement is to establish a framework agreement for the purchase of aeronautical maps, database management and correction services.

The series of aeronautical maps from the Norwegian Air Force [Luftforsvaret (LF)] is used by all aircraft types in the Norwegian Armed Forces during navigation under VFR (visual flight rules) conditions. This includes the F-35, C-130J, P-8, P-3C, AW101, Sea King, Bell 412 and Saab Safari aircraft types. The aeronautical maps are also used by all foreign units that train or operate in Norway. In addition to cartographic objects for navigation purposes, aerial maps contain important information about vertical obstructions, airspace structure and protected areas, among other things.

Qualification Requirement:

Tenderers must be registered in a company register, professional register or a trade register in the country where the tenderer is established. This requirement must be fulfilled by the tenderer himself, it cannot be met by the use of sub-suppliers.

Documentation requirement:

Qualification Requirement:

Tenderers must have the necessary economic and financial capacity to fulfil the contract. A credit rating of 'credit worthy' or equivalent will be sufficient to fulfil the requirement.

If a tenderer will rely on the capacity of other companies to fulfil this requirement, the contracting authority requires that they are severally liable for the execution of the contract.

If a tenderer has valid reasons for not being able to provide the documentation requested by the contracting authority, the tenderer can prove his economic and financial position with any other document that the contracting authority deems suitable.

Documentation requirement:

A credit assessment from a certified credit rating agency based on the most recent known accounting. The rating must not be older than 3 months.

List and brief description of selection criteria:

Qualification Requirement:

Tenderers must have valuable experience from comparable assignments. The term "similar deliveries" means that the tenderer must be able to document experience from the production of analogue aeronautical maps or other relevant map products and/or aeronautical maps or other relevant map products for digital media.

Documentation requirement:

An overview of the tenderer's most relevant assignments in the last 3 years. In order to ensure sufficient competition, documentation of deliveries that the tenderer carried out more than 3 years ago can also be taken into consideration.

The list must include an indication of:

- The assignment value
- Date
- Recipient
- A brief description of the delivery

It is the tenderer's responsibility to confirm relevance through the description.

Qualification Requirement:

Tenderers must have a good and well-functioning quality assurance system. This requirement must be fulfilled by the tenderer himself, it cannot be met by the use of sub-suppliers.

Documentation requirement:

A description of the tenderer's quality assurance methods. If a tenderer is certified in accordance with ISO 9001 or equivalent standards, it is sufficient to present a copy of a valid certificate.

Qualification Requirement:

Tenderers must have a good environment management system. This requirement must be fulfilled by the tenderer himself, it cannot be met by the use of sub-suppliers.

Documentation requirement:

A description of environmental measures that have been implemented in the business. If a tenderer is certified in accordance with ISO 14001, EMAS, or equivalent standards, it is sufficient to present a copy of a valid certificate.
