The trust would wish the successful Supplier to review the current cleaning services offered and make recommendations accordingly.

The contract being tendered is for 3 years in duration from 1.9.2019 to 31.8.2022 and will operate as a fixed price contract.

The academic year is based on a calendar of 195 days. Five days are to be used for staff professional development which means that school will be open to receive students for the legal minimum of 190 days.

Whilst the trust prioritises value for money as a key objective of the competitive tender process, the governing body is not obliged to accept the lowest price.
