- reimburse the Trust for the cost of the salary, superannuation and employer's National Insurance contributions of a Stoma Care Assistant classified as a Top Band 3 employed for a maximum of 37.5 hours per week;
- reimburse the Trust for the Stoma Care Nurse attendance at appropriate NMC courses, professional study days and similar events that support on-going necessary professional training, not to exceed GBP 4 000 per annum. This number may need to be reviewed in the future due to pandemic changes;
- (Optional) Provide a Stoma Care Management System. Patient Identifiable Data is owned by the Trust and in the event that this Agreement is terminated access to the application will be

removed and all related software will be uninstalled. The data will be extracted from the SQL database in spreadsheet (xls) format and returned to the Trust;

- provide a desktop publishing service and printing costs for materials distributed directly to colostomy, ileostomy and urostomy patients, not to exceed GBP 2 000 per annum;
- supply the Trust with one Company Stoma Care Nurse and arrange payment of the cost of salary, superannuation, pension and employers National Insurance contributions of a Company Stoma Care Nurse employed for a maximum of 37.5 hours per week;
- the Trust to provide an ongoing an honorary contract for the company Stoma care nurse.
