The Police and Crime Commissioner for Avon and Somerset Police is seeking responses from interested companies for waste management services. Expressions of interest are invited from

suitably qualified and experienced contractors. This procurement is being undertaken to establish a contract for waste management services for Avon and Somerset Police, Taunton Deane Borough Council and West Somerset Council. The procurement procedures will be undertaken in accordance with the Restricted Procedure set out in the Regulations as per European Procurement Legislation.

The contract will be divided into lots as outlined below:

Lot 1: Co-mingled Recyclables and Residual Waste: To include, but not limited to, general waste, non-confidential paper (including pre-shredded protectively marked paper), tins, cans, plastic, glass, cardboard, newspaper/magazines.

If a large number of companies express an interest, it may be necessary to select a tender list from those applying.
