— the implementation of an expanded media system, which was approved during the period of the 2014 European elections, could not have been anticipated when the initial invitation to tender was prepared. This new situation has tangible impacts, such as the expansion of the lighting grid over broadcast areas and Vox Box in area ASP on the 3rd floor, and the need to acquire new, additional light sources adapted to the new system,

— owing to the fact that the installation was already set up by Inytium in the first phase of the project between 2013 and 2014 (studies of hanging structures and calculation of loads, electrical connections with the Directorate-General for Infrastructure and Logistics, installation of dimmer cabinets, installation of cabling), it is important that the expansion of these existing installations can be carried out by the same service provider for reasons of compatibility with the equipment that is already installed, but also for reasons of responsibility (loadbearing structures, high lighting equipment) and security (structure weighing 10 tonnes and strong electric currents), considering that the production environment is open to MEPs, journalists and the public.
