Objective criteria for choosing the limited number of candidates: Among the candidates who request to participate, the contracting authority (FINAA) will select no more than 3 tenderers to whom the invitation to negotiations is sent to.

If there are more than 3 suitable candidates, the Contracting authority will compare the requests to participate, and select tenderers, using the following criteria.

- a. total number of manufactured flight training devices representing DA42 NG or DA42 VI aircraft type certified as JAA/EASA/FAA FNPT II or higher, 25 %
- b. total number of manufactured flight training devices representing DA42 aircraft (all types) certified as JAA/EASA/FAA FNPT II or higher, 25 %
- c. total number of flight training devices manufactured certified as JAA/EASA/FAA FNPT II or higher, 25 %
- d. number of existing custom made visual databases of Finnish airports, 25 %
