Outdoors, the terrain shall be lowered in the existing parking lot, and the area between the county houses will be improved with new surfaces and planting. A new connecting road between the stair tower and County House 1 (neighbouring building), a new car park facing Parkgata and replacement of all windows in the facades are options in the project.
