The Contractor will provide Project Management Office in order to support INELFE during the tendering, execution and construction phases of the electrical interconnection project between France and Spain via the Biscay Gulf for the period between February 2019 and December 2025.

The project, also called “Biscay Gulf Electrical Interconnection FR-ES” is a joint project developed by INELFE on behalf of Réseau Transport d’Electricité (RTE) from the French part and Red Electrica de Espagna (REE) from the Spanish part.

The project is also supported by the European Union’s Connecting Europe facility (CEF).

In particular the candidate shall be able to propose personnel with communication skills in English, French and Spanish as well as indicate how it intends to maintain stable a Project management Office Team from tendering up to commissioning phase. The candidate is informed that INELFE will have a deep look at proposed organisation as it should be fit-for-purpose on the Project,
- Candidates are required to demonstrate that they have at their disposal sufficient manpower (of relevant and appropriate expertise and experience) and other resources necessary to deliver contracts of this nature, whichever season of the year (holidays ...). The candidates will submit the spreadsheet of available resources (consultants, experts with specialty and level of experience),
- Candidates are required to demonstrate that they have sufficient recent and relevant experience to deliver contracts of this nature associated with the details of the three (3) most relevant contracts executed by the Candidate in the last 5 years,
- Candidates can provide any additional accreditations, certifications or specialties that might be relevant to the scope of requirements for this Contract.
