and Eionet support, support LU standardisation (ISO 19144-3), supporting call for tenders (validation services, CZ protective structures), CLMS harmonisation and evolution, analyse and test LU data provided by NRCs, support for the creation of a pilot CLC+ Legacy instance for 2018 and comparison with CLC2018, testing of OSM and other data for CLC+ Legacy, and 11 other tasks.
