Worcestershire Health and Care NHS Trust (WHCT) is seeking to award a contract for 48 months with two separate 12 month extension periods. Therefore, the potential total length of contract would be 6 years.

HealthTrust Europe ('HTE') acting as a provider of procurement services to Worcestershire Health and Care NHS Trust (WHCT) is seeking to award a contract for Pharmacy Dispensing Services for the mentioned sites in this notice.

The estimated annual value of the contract is c £ 600,000 with a drug dispensing spend of £ 2.63 per annum.
