The course shall have focus on job applicants with relevant higher education, such as engineer, civil engineer, architect or other relevant technical background, and with requirements for skills upgrading for getting employment. The composition of course participants may differ in accordance with the labour market situation. The objective of the course is that the participants shall get relevant ordinary work.
