Objective criteria for choosing the limited number of candidates: Financial capacity: The candidates (or lead contractor if a consortium) must have a turnover of minimum 5 000 000 GBP per year over the last 5 years. Current assets must exceed current liabilities.

Technical capacity: Submit summary of up to a maximum of 10 projects carried out in the last 5 years in the areas of low volume rural roads; environmental mitigation and climate change.

At least 5 projects must have a minimum value of 250 000 GBP. Candidates should have significant experience in sub-Saharan African countries in the last 5 years.

Secondary Selection Criteria:

If more than 6 eligible candidates meet the above selection criteria, the relative strengths and weaknesses of the applications of these candidates will be re-examined to identify the best candidates. Factors taken into consideration during re-examination are:

- Strength and relevance of CV's,
- Availability of Staff,
- Strength of project experience,
- Experience on DFID (and/or AFCAP) contracts,
- In the selection of supplier, some preference will be given to the involvement of national organisations, national staff and women.
