NHS Eastern Cheshire CCG is looking for a provider of primary care services as part of this NHS England initiative.

NHS England has developed seven core national requirements for the delivery of improved access in order to bring parity to the Improved access offer across the country and these requirements are:

- timing of appointments,
- capacity,
- measurement,
- advertising and ease of access,
- digital,
- inequalities,
- effective access to wider whole-system services.
