- the service is for the provision of hostel accommodation in Yeovil and associated housing management and support; it is expected that the costs of accommodation will largely be met by the service users through an occupancy agreement. It is anticipated service users will be in receipt of housing benefit and/or universal credit,
- the service provider will be expected to work closely with other local partners/delivery organisations to support customers and reduce homelessness in South Somerset.
