The WMS solution will include product inventory, warehousing operations and stock control management as standard functionality along with associated supporting API interfaces.

The potential budget for the WMS system is between 300 000 GBP — 450 000 GBP total excluding VAT for the potential 5 year contract (3 years initially plus 2 further periods of up to 24 months).
